The Back Health CME Resource article, written by **Dr. Arani Kulamurugan et al.**, focuses on *Back and Neck Pain, Pain Clinics and Interventional Pain Management in Canada*. It causes intense itching in infected individuals. This infection is highly contagious and is transmitted through direct and prolonged skin-to-skin contact. Prompt diagnosis and treatment are essential to prevent complications and transmission to others.

In his Dementia article, **Dr. Michael Gordon** presents *The Future Approach to Dementia Prevention: Beyond Medications*, and in his Ethics article **Dr. Gordon** examines *Why is the Brain Like a Pickle?*
